

MIGRATION FLYOVERS 2010

As a rule, departures happen within 10 minutes of sunrise so you will want to be in place at the viewing site by that time. **Remember** that our ability to fly on any given day is entirely weather dependent, and we rarely know more than a few minutes in advance of take-off whether or not we will be flying that day. OM crew will be on hand at Flyover Viewing Locations to answer your questions. They will be equipped with aviation radios so you can hear pilot transmissions and will have OM Gear for purchase.

	DEPARTURE	On the Necedah National Wildlife Refuge (between the towns of Tomah and Necedah) <u>Directions</u> : Exit Hwy 21 onto Headquarters Road leading into the refuge. Viewing spot is at the DU Observation Platform which will be on your right about 0.7 miles off the Hwy. Click here for Google Map.
1	Juneau, WI	Sorry, no suitable view location is available.
2	S. Juneau, WI	Sorry, no suitable view location is available.
3	Sauk, WI	Ferry Bluff: (State Natural Area situated on the Wisconsin River, just S/E of Sauk City.) <u>Directions</u> : From the intersection of Highways 60 and 12 west of Sauk City, go west on Highway 60 ~4.4 miles, then south on Ferry Crossing Bluff Road ~1.1 miles to a parking area and canoe landing at the end of the road. A trail leads to the top of Cactus Bluff (300ft), a spot which usually provides spectacular views of the cranes and planes as they pass by. Click here for Google Map.
4	Green, WI	Viewing site is at the top of a hill on County Road N, just north (~1/2 mile) of the intersection of County Roads N and C. Coming along CR N from the north, the apex of the hill is just past Ron-Hill Lane (on your right). Coming from the south, if you pass Ron-Hill Lane (on your left) you've gone a bit too far. 5	Winnebago, IL	Viewing site is on N. Hoisington Road, just outside of the town of Pecatonica, IL. The exact location is only 0.68 miles from the intersection of Saunders and N. Hoisington Road. Click here for Google Map.
6	LaSalle, IL	Viewing site is on the east side of the town of Sheridan, IL at the junction of East Pleasant Street and County Hwy 32 / Main Street / N41st Road. As a landmark, across the street at the top of the 'T' where East Pleasant meets County Hwy 32 / Main Street / N41st Road is Sheridan Cemetery. Click for Google Map
7	Livingston, IL	new Livingston County Flyover Viewing Location is on 2000E Road, just south of where it is crossed by 1200N Road – adjacent to a silo location numbered 11689. Click for Google Map
8	Piatt, IL	Viewing site is at the easterly edge of the town of Milmine at the intersection of 22 (Milmine Road) and Bodman, just before crossing the railway tracks. Click for Google Map
9	Cumberland, IL	Viewing site is along CR626E (also called Frontage Road) just east (approx 1/2 mile) off Montrose Black Top Road (also called Spring Creek Road) and just west of CR 575E. Click for Google Map
10	Wayne, IL	Directly east of Barnhill, IL, just south (0.2 miles) of the junction of County Road 200N and County Road 2400E on the top of a small rise. Click for Google Map.
11	Union, KY	Viewing site is at the junction of Highways 130 and 270, east of the town of Henshaw. Click for Google Map.
12	Marshall, KY	Viewing site in front of the Lighthouse Missionary Baptist Church on CR1264 (also known as Flat Road) which is off Hwy 402. CR1264 (Flat Road) is between Jackson School Road and Wilkins Road. Click for Google Map
13	Carrol, TN	Viewing site is at the junction of Price Road and Long Rock Church Road just outside of the town of Huntingdon. Click for Google Map
14	Hardin, TN	Viewing site is off 13780 Hwy 69 South, Savannah, TN. Use the entrance marked 'North Gate' (which will be unlocked by 6:45am) and follow the road in and to the right going down the hill. Turn right where the sign says Watermelon Hill, and proceed up the hill to the viewing stands. Click for Google Map
15	Franklin, AL	Viewing site is at the old parking lot at Russellville Airport. It is just off Hwy 243, right

		beside the fuel tanks. Click for Google Map
16	Walker, AL	Viewing site is on CR 20/New Parrish Hwy, east of the town of Parrish at the intersection of 269 and 20, approx. 1¼ miles on south side. Drive up hill to the church. Click for Google Map
17	Chilton, AL	Viewing site is south of Montevallo on CR 107 which is off CR 73. Park on CR 107 just a short way east of where CR 119 meets CR 107. Click for Google Map
18	Lowndes, AL	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
19	Pike, AL	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
20	Clay, GA	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
21	Decatur, GA	Viewing site is outside of Climax, GA on Bell Dixon Road, just east of where it is intersected by Fewell Road. Click for Google Map
22	Jefferson, FL	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
23	Wakulla, FL	The Arrival Flyover event and viewing site is at the San Marcos de Apalache Park in the town of St. Marks. South of where Hwy 363 (Woodville Hwy) intersects Coastal Hwy 98, 363 becomes Port Leon Drive. Follow Port Leon Drive to the end, turn right onto Riverside Drive/Old Fort Road and watch for the Arrival Signs on your left. You will be directed to parking. Click for Google Map
24	Madison, FL	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
25	Gilchrist, FL	Sorry, no suitable view location is available
26	Marion, FL	The Arrival Flyover event and viewing site is at the Dunnellon-Marion County Airport, off HWY 484 just east of the town of Dunnellon. Turn north off 484 onto SW 147 th Circle, then right onto SW 111 th Street. You will be directed to parking. Click for Google Map
27	Citrus, FL	Viewing site is the Wal-Mart parking lot, 3826 South Suncoast Blvd. Homosassa, FL Click for Google Map.
